

FOR NATIVE-BORN AMERICAN WOMEN:

WHAT YOU CAN DO FOR AMERICANISM.

1. Be neighborly with immigrant families. Take at least one immigrant family and be a friend and neighbor and an interpreter of America to it.
2. Make every national holiday Americanization Day by asking immigrants to your homes.
3. Give up a part of each day getting acquainted with your immigrant neighbors.
4. Teach the language to a class of alien women, getting your introduction from the schools, settlements or Americanization workers.
5. Discourage in your children the use of immigrant nicknames.
6. See that the sanitary conditions of the stores, houses, streets and vacant lots in the immigrant sections receive equal attention from the authorities.
7. Get together. America is a weak nation so long as class and racial lines prevail.
8. Help alien women in industry to make right adjustments and see that they receive such protection as they need.
9. Encourage aliens to become citizens, and help introduce them to our political life, if you live in a state where women vote.
10. Provide special protection, care and guidance for the immigrant mother, as regards unlicensed midwives, objectionable lodgers. Help her to keep pace with her American-born children.

2. Government is created to secure each individual in his inalienable rights, subject to the guarantee of the same rights, in all other individuals.

3. This government is a government of individuals grouped as THE PEOPLE, FOR THE PEOPLE, BY THE PEOPLE.

4. This government is a government by law not a government by will of any individual.

5. This government is a government by the majority of the people.

6. Allegiance belongs to the people organized as a government not to any individual.

7. Equality before the law.

8. No class domination. Abolishment of rank and caste.

9. Free compulsory education in order to maintain free government and a people free.

10. The states form a union inseparable and therefore a nation.
